Commissioner Benner opened the meeting at 10:00 AM on March 17, 2014 with the Pledge to the Flag and a moment of silence.

**Public Comment:** None.

Commissioner Rudy made a motion to approve the minutes of March 10, 2014. Commissioner Naylor seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Commissioner Naylor made a motion to approve the warrant list for March 17, 2014 for a total of \$131,252.10. Commissioner Rudy seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Commissioner Naylor made a motion to approve the Sharepoint Website Program with the County Commissioners Association in the amount of \$2,969.55. Commissioner Rudy seconded the motion. Motion carried. The County Commissioners Association of Pennsylvania (CCAP) provides a secure SharePoint Services platform for website hosting for the county. This is an annual service agreement.

Commissioner Naylor made a motion to approve the Planned Service Agreement with Tom Stephenson Generator Service, Inc. for preventative maintenance for the emergency generators for 911. This is a one year service contract for \$2,995.00. Commissioner Rudy seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Based on the recommendation of the Cumberland Perry Drug & Alcohol Commission, Commissioner Naylor made a motion to approve the following amended contracts:

- Diakon Family Life Services increase \$55,000 to \$125,000
- NHS Human Services (Stephens Center) increase \$17,000 to \$25,000
- Perry Human Services increase \$100,000 to \$125,000

- Guadenzia, Inc. increase \$125,000 to \$250,000
- Perry Human Services increase \$96,190 to \$106,190

Commissioner Naylor made a motion to recommend to the Harrisburg Hershey Regional Visitors Board to appoint Rhonda Campbell to represent Perry County on the HHRVB Board of Directors. Commissioner Rudy seconded the motion. Motion carried. Commissioner Rudy thought that Rhonda Campbell working with the Chamber will be a positive connection for the County.

**Employee Status:**

Commissioner Naylor made a motion to accept the letter of resignation for Harry Nazzaro, care manager, Office of Aging, effective March 17, 2014. Commissioner Rudy seconded the motion. Motion carried.
