Commissioner Benner opened the meeting at 10:00 AM on May 13, 2013 with the Pledge to the Flag and a moment of silence.

Commissioner Rudy made a motion to approve the minutes of May 6, 2013. Commissioner Naylor seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Commissioner Rudy made a motion to approve the warrant list in the amount of \$84,888.92 for the week of May 13, 2013. Commissioner Naylor seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Commissioner Naylor made a motion to approve the Agreement with G.R. Sponaugle & Sons, Inc. for the purchase of an aluminum exhaust duct and fan for the shower room at the Perry County Prison for a cost of \$2,750. Commissioner Rudy seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Based on the review of Michelle Harris, Aging Director, Commissioner Rudy made a motion to award the bid for Nutritional Services (meals on wheels) to The Nutrition Group, 580 Wendel Road, Irwin, PA. Frey's Commissary's bid was returned unopened because of not meeting the criteria. The Nutrition Group's bid was opened for a price of \$4.67 unit cost for approximately 30,000 projected meals for home delivery, \$4.67 unit cost for approximately 12,500 yearly projected meals and \$3.61 unit cost for approximately 300 shelf stable meals for a total of \$199,558.00. Commissioner Naylor seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Employee Status: Commissioner Naylor made a motion to approve Kyle Miller as a part time dispatcher, grade 6, after completing his training, effective May 6, 2013. Commissioner Rudy seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Commissioner Rudy made a motion to terminate Dustin Hertzler, as a part time dispatcher, trainee, effective May 6, 2013. Commissioner Naylor seconded the motion. Motion carried.

At the salary board meeting on May 6, 2013, Commissioner Naylor asked the Treasurer, Mary Reisinger if she would make a motion to appoint Susan Dunkleberger as Deputy Treasurer, so it is recorded in the minutes. Based on the recommendation, Commissioner Naylor made a motion to also reflect this in the Commissioners Minutes. Commissioner Rudy seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Solicitors Report- The solicitor had nothing that required action. Re- apportionment for voting precincts appears to be finally approved. Commissioner Rudy asked the question what steps must be done before abolishing the position of jury commissioners. Solicitor Bunt answered prior to approving a Resolution you are required to meet with the President Judge and discuss this action.

Public Comments: Russell Gibney asked if the County had any contacts for D.E.P. to notify them of sludge being hauled on local farms. Mr. Gibney asked if the County could do anything to prevent this from happening and if they are required to do any testing.

Commissioner Naylor made a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Rudy seconded the motion. Motion carried. The meeting adjourned at 10:20 A.M.
