During the month of May, the Alliance of Bikers Aimed Toward Education of Pennsylvania will continue its advocacy of motorcycle safety and awareness. Commissioner Rudy seconded the motion. Based on the Cumberland Perry Drug & Alcohol Commission, Commissioner Naylor made a motion to approve Amendment #10 to the HealthChoices Contract with the PA Department of Human Services. The purpose of this amendment is to bring the County-DHS contract into compliance with Medicaid and CHIP Managed Care and is part of a five Counties collaborative.
