Bill Myers addressed the commissioners to a concern regarding the implementing values article that he read in the Times.

Commissioner Naylor made a motion to approve the minutes of November 8, 2010. Commissioner Benner seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Commissioner Benner made a motion to sign the warrant list in the amount of \$351,941.67. Commissioner Naylor seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Commissioner Naylor made a motion to certify the following: Taxable Assessments for Perry County at \$2,936,499,7000. Certify Public Utilities exempt assessment's at \$6,590,100. Certify tax exempt excluding public utilities at \$346,833,300. Total of tax exempt is \$353,423,400. The total is \$3,289,923,100. There is a total of 23,434 parcels in the county. 22,737 are taxable parcels. 35% of parcels received a significant reduction, 32% remained the same, 33% had a significant increase. Tim Barr, 21st Century Appraisals, Inc. attended the meeting and complemented the Board on how the county handled the re-assessment. Commissioner Benner seconded the motion. All agreed. Motion carried.

Based on the recommendation of the Cumberland-Perry Drug & Alcohol Commission, Commissioner Naylor made a motion to enter into an Agreement with the American Lung Association to provide tobacco prevention services and school based youth tobacco cessation services to residents of Cumberland and Perry County in the amount of \$31,575.84. Commissioner Benner seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Commissioner Naylor made a motion to reappoint Lloyd Byers of Liverpool as Conservation District Director to the Conservation District Board. Commissioner Benner seconded the motion. Motion carried. Mr. Byers term expires December 2014.

Commissioner Benner made a motion to adopt Resolution 2010-16. Commissioner Naylor seconded the motion. Resolution 2010-16 authorizes the execution of the subrecipient Agreement with the Borough of Landisburg for the use of PA Community Block Grant Program Funds in the amount of \$10,500. Commissioner seconded the motion. All agreed. Motion carried.
