Commissioner Amsler opened the meeting at 10:00 AM on December 27, 2010 with the Pledge to the Flag and a moment of silence.

Commissioner Benner made a motion to approve the minutes of December 20, 2010. Commissioner Naylor seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Commissioner Naylor made a motion to sign the warrant list in the amount of \$228,594.35. Commissioner Benner seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Based on the recommendation of Omar Syed, Tri-County Planning, Commissioner Benner made a motion to transfer CDBG funds in the amount of \$13,480.12 from the year 2009 to the Duncannon Sewer project due to change orders and other related issues. Commissioner Naylor seconded the motion. All agreed. Motion carried.

Commissioner Naylor made a motion as a result of the 2010 reassessment to establish the revenue neutral millage at 3.3125. Commissioner Benner seconded the motion. All agreed. Motion carried.

Commissioner Benner made a motion to adopt Resolution #2010-16. Commissioner Naylor seconded the motion. Motion carried. Resolution #2010-16 adopts the 2011 County Budget in the amount of \$15,453,005.00.

Commissioner Benner made a motion to set the milage rate on real estate for 2011 at 3.3125 mills. Commissioner Naylor seconded the motion. All agreed. Motion carried.

Commissioner Naylor made a motion to adopt Ordinance 2 of 2010. Commissioner Amsler seconded the motion. Commissioner Benner voted against adopting the Ordinance. Motion carried. Ordinance 2 of 2010, establishes a 0% yearly increase for elected officials effective 2012 and 2013, and a 3% increase for 2014 and 2015. A copy of this Ordinance is on file in the Register and Recorder's Office.
