Commissioner Benner opened the meeting at 10:00 AM on September 16, 2013 with the Pledge to the Flag and a moment of silence. Commissioner Rudy was absent.

Public Comment: A public hearing was held on Monday, September 16, 2013 at 9:45 a.m. for public input for the approval of Community Development Block Grant budget modifications for FY 2010 and 2011. Commissioner Naylor made a motion to approve the reallocation of funding from the Blain Borough Water and Oliver Township Sewer Project to the Everhartville Sewer Extension Project in the amount of \$179,417.13. Commissioner Benner seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Sam Wagner, District Governor, Lions Club International, was presented a Proclamation designating the month of October as “National White Cane Safety Month”. The Lion Club members will be at various locations in the County doing fundraising for eye research, eye glasses and treatment for seniors who are at risk for eye disease. Mr. Wagner has been a member of the Lions Club for 46 years.
