The Election Board met on Monday, October 25, 2021 at 11:00 a.m. The meeting was conducted via WebEx video/telephone conference and in person in the Commissioners' Meeting Room. The meeting was recorded by the County.

Approval of the Minutes: Commissioner Allen made a motion to approve the minutes from the October 18, 2021 meeting. Commissioner Watson seconded the motion. The motion passed with Commissioner Allen and Watson in favor. Commissioner Eby abstained. Motion carried.

Meeting Business: Election Day Procedures: Commissioner Watson stated that Jonathan Marks, Deputy Secretary for Elections and Commissions from the Pennsylvania Department of State, recognized Elections Director, Bonnie Delancey on Friday, October 22nd for her dedication and years of service working in elections. Solicitor Bunt also congratulated Bonnie on the recognition from Mr. Marks.

Bonnie Delancey said that October 26th was the deadline to submit an application for an absentee or mail in ballot. She said that her office is extremely busy and there is a lot of work to be completed prior to Election Day, including the poll books and kits. Ms. Delancey commented that residents have been contacting the office regarding problems with the postal service and ballots not being delivered timely. She also commented on the previous discussion on reducing the noise in the conference room on election night. Ms. Delancey stated that she recommended that only the Judge of Elections and Minority Inspector of one precinct be in the room at a time. Discussion continued regarding reducing the noise in the conference room. The Board also discussed election day and night work assignments.

Commissioner Watson commented that the next Election Board meeting would be held on November 1, 2021 at 11:00 a.m.
