**Public Comments:** Rob Troxell, from Upward Broadband, asked for an update on the County broadband initiative project.

**Approval of Minutes:** Commissioner Eby made a motion to approve the minutes from the January 10, 2022 Commissioners’ Meeting. Commissioner Allen seconded the motion. All agreed. Motion carried.

**Approval of the Warrant List(s):** Commissioner Eby made a motion to approve the 2021 warrant lists totaling \$433,527.66 and the 2022 warrant lists totaling \$206,290.92. Commissioner Allen seconded the motion. All agreed. Motion carried.
