Public Comments: Sarah Geesaman, Director of Voter Registration/Elections, said the Freedom Building was working out well for her department and she thanked Maintenance for all the work they did and continue to do in their building.

Approval of Minutes: Commissioner Watson made a motion approve the minutes from the February 27, 2023 meeting. Commissioner Reisinger seconded the motion. All agreed. Motion carried.

Meeting Business: Commissioner Reisinger made a motion to approve Resolution 2023-04 Adopting the PICTURE PERRY Comprehensive Plan. Commissioner Allen seconded the motion. Commissioners Watson and Allen recognized Jason Finnerty for the work he did to get the plan together and to the point of adoption. All agreed. Motion carried.

Commissioner Reisinger made a motion to approve the lease addendum with DAK-SON Inc. for the Children & Youth building. Commissioner Watson seconded the motion. All agreed. Motion carried.

Commissioner Watson made a motion to approve the agreement with Karen Barclay for Prison transition services. Commissioner Reisinger seconded the motion. All agreed. Motion carried.

Commissioner Watson made a motion to approve the Children & Youth Services 2022/2023 Purchase of Service agreement (below). Commissioner Reisinger seconded the motion. All agreed. Motion carried.

Commissioner Watson made a motion to approve the appointments of Reed Weiland and Nolan Littlewood to the position of Part Time Dispatcher Trainee in the 911 Center effective March 7, 2023 at an hourly rate of \$11.84. Commissioner Reisinger seconded the motion. All agreed. Motion carried.

Solicitor's Report: Solicitor Bunt reminded attendees that the Election Board would meet at 11:00 a.m. and the Board of Assessment Appeals at 12:00 p.m.

Public Comments: Jason Finnerty thanked the Commissioners for their support and adoption of PICTURE PERRY. He also thanked the 22 municipalities that joined the plan. Mr. Finnerty said he hopes that the remaining municipalities that did not sign on will join on at a later date.
