Approval of Minutes: Commissioner Watson made a motion to approve the minutes from the May 2, 2022 Commissioners' Meeting. Commissioner Eby seconded the motion. All agreed. Motion carried.

Meeting Business: Commissioner Watson made a motion to approve the proposal from G.R. Sponaugle for the Prison hot water booster project at a cost of \$7,782. Commissioner Allen seconded the motion. The motion passed with Commissioners Allen and Watson in favor, and Commissioner Eby opposed.

Commissioner Eby made a motion, based on the recommendation of Cumberland-Perry MH/IDD and the fact that the Cumberland County Commissioners already approved the contracts, to approve the MH/IDD contracts for Early Intervention, Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities, and Mental Health for fiscal year 2021/2022 in the total amount of \$3,536,310 (attached). Commissioner Watson seconded the motion. All agreed. Motion carried. Commissioner Eby stated that the state funding for MH/IDD services falls short of the true need and the general public must reach out to their legislatures about the lack of funding for the vital needs. Commissioner Allen urged individuals to contact the Governor's Office as well.

Employee Status: Commissioner Watson made a motion to approve the appointment of Jason Klunk to the position of Full Time Sergeant at the Perry County Prison effective May 10, 2022 at an hourly rate of \$28.79. Commissioner Eby seconded the motion. All agreed. Motion carried.

Kristie Gantt, Director of Children & Youth Services, stated that Ms. Rabin was part of the CWEB program and all clearances had been completed. Commissioner Eby made a motion to approve the appointment of Amy Rabin to the position of Unpaid Intern at the Children & Youth Services Department effective May 10, 2022. Commissioner Watson seconded the motion. All agreed. Motion carried.

Solicitor's Report: Solicitor Bunt stated that the Prison contract was not ratified by the union and therefore the next step would be binding interest arbitration.
