Commissioner Allen opened the meeting at 10:00 a.m. on June 12, 2023 with the Pledge to the Flag and a moment of silence. The meeting was conducted in person and via WebEx telephone/video conference in the Commissioners' Conference Room. The meeting was recorded by the County.

Announcements/Updates: Commissioner Allen stated that the Perry County Fair would be held beginning August 15 through August 19. He further said to contact Commissioner Reisinger for fair booklets.

Approval of the Minutes: Commissioner Watson made a motion approve the minutes from the June 5, 2023 meeting. Commissioner Reisinger seconded the motion. All agreed. Motion carried.

Employee Recognition: Commissioner Allen recognized Janette Medvidovich, from the Probation Department, for 25 years of service to the County.

Meeting Business: Commissioner Reisinger made a motion to commit \$75,000 of Perry County's opioid settlement funds for continuation of the Perry County Prison Vivitrol Program for 18 months commencing July 1, 2023 through December 31, 2024. Commissioner Watson seconded the motion. All agreed. Motion carried.

Jack Carroll stated that the Vivitrol Program has been in operation for the past four years and was funded through PCCD funding. He further said that the funding is ending on June 30th, and allotting opioid funding to the program will allow it to continue at the prison.

Commissioner Reisinger made a motion to allocate \$30,000 of Perry County's opioid settlement funds to pay for costs incurred by the Perry County Prison to ensure that offenders upon their admission to the Perry County Prison receiving medical assisted treatment and services for opioid use disorders continue to receive the same during their period of incarceration at the Perry County Prison for the 18-month period commencing July 1, 2023 through December 31, 2024. Commissioner Watson seconded the motion. All agreed. Motion carried.

Commissioner Watson made a motion to approve the memorandum of understanding with eRecording Partners Network, LLC. Commissioner Reisinger seconded the motion. All agreed. Motion carried. Wendy Welfley, Register and Recorder/Clerk of the Orphan's Court, explained the memorandum. She said that eRecording Partners Network will be able to expand e-filing for not only Register & Recorder records, but also Clerk of the Orphans Court documents.

Commissioner Watson made a motion to approve the Cumberland-Perry Drug & Alcohol Commission contract addendum (below). Commissioner Reisinger seconded the motion. All agreed. Motion carried.
