Public Comments: Dave Magee commented that he was informed by the Marysville Police Chief, that the Sheriff's Department no longer wants to be involved with the Drug Task Force. He said he was aware that funds from previous drug confiscations in Marysville had been used to get an undercover vehicle for the task force work. He said he was discouraged by this situation and wondered if this should be looked into. Mr. Magee also asked how an organization goes about submitting for grant funding with the County, now that the grants advisory group had been formed.

Dan Kilgore stated that he continues to work on zoning for the land he wants to donate to the County for a drug and alcohol recovery facility. He said the township planning commission seems to be amenable to the project. He provided the Commissioners with some handouts regarding the proposed project.
