Public Comments: Warden Harvey stated that former Warden David Yeingst passed away on Sunday, July 2, 2023. He retired from the Perry County Prison in 2018 and had worked for the County for 14 years.

Sarah Geesaman, Voter Registration Director stated that Deb Shrawder and herself had attended the Eastern PA Directors meeting recently. It was nice to be updated on the new procedures for their office.

Approval of Minutes: Commissioner Watson made a motion approve the minutes from the June 26, 2023 meeting. Commissioner Reisinger seconded the motion. All agreed. Motion carried.

Approval of the Warrant List(s): Commissioner Reisinger made a motion to approve the warrant lists totaling \$637,290.72. Commissioner Watson seconded the motion. All agreed. Motion carried.

Commissioner Watson made the motion to approve the MH/IDD contracts for Early Intervention for fiscal year 2022/2023 with the total amount of \$434,400. Commissioner Reisinger seconded the motion. All agreed. Motion carried.

Commissioner Watson made the motion to approve the MH/IDD contracts for Early Intervention for fiscal year 2023/2024 in the total amount of \$529,952. Commissioner Reisinger seconded the motion. All agreed. Motion carried.
