Commissioner Allen opened the meeting at 10:00 a.m. on August 22, 2022 with the Pledge to the Flag and a moment of silence in remembrance Commissioner Eby's mother Ruth. The meeting was conducted in person in the Commissioners' Conference Room. The meeting was recorded by the County.

**Public Comments:** Jason Finnerty stated that letters will be going out to municipalities to vet collected projects for the Picture Perry County Comprehensive Plan. He commented that another township had signed onto the plan and he said he would be talking at the Perry COG meeting to help encourage additional municipalities to sign onto the plan. Mr. Finnerty said that the municipality participation in the Picture Perry County Comprehensive Plan is the most to date.

Rob Troxell, from Upward Broadband, commented that his organization had participated in the Perry County Fair and had the chance to speak with many County residents. He said that he did hear hesitancy from individuals but he said he looked forward to building confidence in Upward Broadband service.

Frank Campbell expressed appreciation for the CDBG funding that allowed household hookup to the sanitary sewer system in Howe Township. He said the last household was recently connected to the system.

Commissioner Watson made a motion to approve the Memorandum of Agreement for Services with the Pennsylvania Department of State for Albert Sensor services and stated that it was for cybersecurity services and was State funded. Commissioner Allen seconded the motion. All agreed. Motion carried.

Commissioner Watson made a motion to approve the Juvenile Probation Services Grant Agreement. Commissioner Allen seconded the motion. All agreed. Motion carried.

Commissioner Watson made a motion to approve the Memorandum of Understanding with Mifflin-Juniata Area Agency on Aging for FED assessments. Commissioner Allen seconded the motion. All agreed. Motion carried. Greg Wirth, Director of Aging, stated that due to staff shortages in Mifflin-Juniata County, Perry County Aging has been asked to assist with assessments and will be reimbursed for mileage and per FED assessment.

Commissioner Allen made a motion to approve the Contract for Pass Through Funding with Cumberland County for Pennsylvania Link services. Commissioner Watson seconded the motion. All agreed. Motion carried.

Commissioner Watson made a motion to approve the 911 Emergency Communication Professional Consulting Services proposal with Mission Critical Partners and commented that it was a 1-year contract. Commissioner Allen seconded the motion. All agreed. Motion carried.

Commissioner Watson made a motion to approve the MH/IDD contracts for Early Intervention, Intellectual & Developmental Disabilities, and Mental Health for FY 2021/2022 in the total amount of \$3,627,073 (attached). Commissioner Allen seconded the motion. All agreed. Motion carried.

Commissioner Watson made a motion to approve the MH/IDD contracts for Early Intervention, Intellectual & Developmental Disabilities, and Mental Health for FY 2022/2023 in the total amount of \$234,415 (attached). Commissioner Allen seconded the motion. All agreed. Motion carried.
