

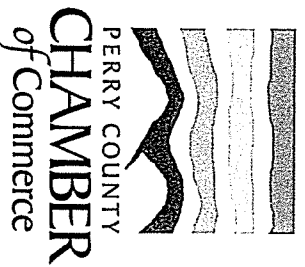

Section 2.

The Executive Board shall have full charge of the affairs of the Association between Conventions. It shall meet annually prior to the Annual Convention at a time and place selected by the President. At that time, it shall confirm or amend the report of the Treasurer, certify the date of the forthcoming Convention, assist, and cooperate with the Secretary in preparation of a suitable program, and transact any other business that may come to its attention. The President may call a special meeting of the Executive Board as occasions for its service may arise.

Section 3.

The President shall appoint the following standing committees: a Resolution Committee, a Nomination Committee, and Special Committee for specific purposes as occasion may require.

Section 4.

The Resolution Committee shall annually present proposed resolution for consideration by the Convention.

Section 5.

The Executive Board shall have full voting privileges.

**ARTICLE X
DUES**

The dues requested shall be at the rate of thirty-five (\$35) dollars annually. If the authorized activities of the Association require it, the dues may be fixed at a higher rate after first being approved by a majority vote of the convention. Any Township failing, neglecting, or refusing to pay its Association dues shall be deprived of free access or all Special Privileges of the Association.

**ARTICLE XI
AMENDMENTS**

These By-Laws may be amended at any regular meeting of the Association by submitting proposed amendments in writing sixty (60) days prior to the Convention and by a two-thirds vote of the members present and voting.

MINUTES OF THE 2023 CONVENTION

The 110th Annual Convention of the Perry County Association of Township Officials, (PCATO) was held on September 9, 2023, at the Perry County Fairgrounds, Newport with an attendance of 135 including the following executive board members present:

John Hess, Jr.,-President
Zachary Kuhn-2nd Vice President
Jill Hoover-Secretary/Treasurer

Keith Finton-1st Vice President
Art Lindsay-Past President
Diana McPherson-Asst. Secretary Jim Fuller-Member at Large

Following the welcome and invocation by President - John Hess, Jr., the general session of the Convention body was convened to order with the Pledge of Allegiance to the United States Flag. Present John Hess, Jr. commented that the convention was being recorded for secretarial purposes.

Sara Keller from Senator Greg Rothman's office was the first to speak. Hello, I am Sara Keller on behalf of Senator Rothman. He regrets that he could not be here in person today, but I'm delighted to be with you as usual every year. I do want to point out that I have literature back there and I have a lot of copies of grants for municipal leaders. I will be here until noon, feel free to pick them up. I would like them to be a resource for you. I also have some specifically for first responders as well; so, feel free to pick up one of those and for the senator, he would like to pass on some legislative updates, I think Holly and Dave have touched on a couple of these already. One is the Senate Bill giving expanded the flexibility for county and municipal bridges, by allowing monies allocated to Act 89 of 2013 and Act 44 of 2007 to be used on municipal owned bridges, the bill is awaiting Senate Transportation Committee, and as it currently stands, those funds can only be used on county owned bridges. Going on to Senate Bill 666, which was introduced by Senator Rothman, which is EV Electric Vehicle fee, it's going to streamline the process that allows electric vehicles owners to pay their yearly fees; while also insuring they distribute their fair share towards road and bridges that we all use. The Senator wanted to convey he recognizes the necessary role that roads and bridges play in your working districts, and he is committed to a joint conversation between PennDOT, Representative Stambaugh and the Commissioners to addressing those issues swiftly. The Senator also introduced a resolution to study how repairs to roads and bridges can be done more quickly and more efficiently to reduce the cost and time necessary to provide good effective service. Short and sweet I will be in the back, if you need anything, have a lovely day.

Representative Perry Stambaugh - Thank you and thanks for all of you do for Perry County and for your local municipalities it's very much appreciated, and I know you are doing it because you want to give back to your community and thank you for your service. One of the things that came out of the Area Agency of Aging hearing that were held at different senior centers, was the concern from seniors that there were not handicapped accesses to their polling places; now we checked, and everyone has handicapped access at their polling places, but in some cases it's not very well marked. We already have prying eyes on our election process right now, so please make sure that if you want people to get into your polling place, that you put some signage out that shows people where those handicapped entrances and exits are, so that they know. I was surprised at how many seniors at these events said their polling places are not handicapped accessible, when it is. So, it's something to look

Section 2.

The Secretary/Treasurer and Assistant Secretary shall keep a correct record of minutes of all meetings including those of the Executive Board, shall maintain a complete roll of the membership, shall to all correspondence, and shall perform all other duties pertaining to a secretaryship or that the President may require of same. The Secretary shall be the custodian of all Association property and shall turn the same over to his or her successor in office.

Section 3.

The Secretary/Treasurer shall be charged with the responsibility in the preparation of a suitable program for the forthcoming convention, shall be given full assistance and cooperation of the Executive Board and / or others that may be called upon and shall be compensated at a rate of five hundred (\$500) dollars per year.

Section 4.

The Secretary/Treasurer of the Association shall receive and collect all monies due to the Association, shall deposit funds in a bank in the name of the Association, shall pay out same on approved orders.

ARTICLE VIII

SUCCESSION IN OFFICE

Section 1.

In case the President elect should be for any reason be unable to perform the duties of his office, then the first Vice-President, and after him the second Vice-President, shall serve until such time as the President is again able to perform the duties.

Section 2.

In case the Secretary/Treasurer becomes incapacitated to perform the duties of the office, or to direct them to be done, then the President with the approval of the Executive Board shall appoint someone with full authority to serve until such time as the Secretary/Treasurer is again able to perform the duties.

Section 3.

The President shall not serve more than two (2) years consecutively.

ARTICLE IX

EXECUTIVE BOARD AND COMMITTEES

Section 1.

The Executive Board shall consist of six members: the President, the first Vice-President, the second Vice-President, the Secretary/ Treasurer, and the immediate Past-President, and the Member at Large.

**ARTICLE V
MEETINGS**

Section 1. There shall be an Annual Convention of the Association held during the year in Pennsylvania at a suitable place and time selected by the Executive Board.

Section 2. The President may call a special meeting of the Association or any members of any branch thereof when authorized to do so by the Executive Board.

**ARTICLE VI
OFFICERS**

Section 1. The officers of the Association shall be a President, a first Vice-President, a second Vice-President, a Secretary/Treasurer- (shall be the same person), and an Assistant Secretary.

Section 2. The term of service of the officer shall be for two (2) consecutive years from the close of an Annual Convention until the close of the second Annual Convention.

Section 3. The officers of the Association shall be elected near the close of the Convention. They shall assume the duties of their offices immediately after the close of that session and continue to serve until their successors are elected.

Section 4. The above-named officers and the immediate, Past-President and Member-at-Large shall be known as the Executive Board.

**ARTICLE VII
DUTIES OF OFFICERS**

Section 1. The President shall call all regular meetings, shall preside at all meetings, shall appoint all committees and be ex-officio member of each, shall perform all other duties generally incumbent on a President, and shall be compensated at the rate of seventy-five (\$75) dollars per year.

at as you get your polling place ready for election time. I'm on the house transportation committee, eventually the state of Pennsylvania is going to have to look at doing a full comprehensive overhaul on transportation policy. However it takes shape, I don't think anyone knows at this point, but one of the things I am definitely going to keep my eye on, is that whatever is done on state level also helps out, townships and boroughs with making sure you get enough money for your rural roads and bridges. We already know we have statewide support which is a drop in a hole with county road needs and township road needs, so making sure that liquid fuels tax money is rolling in at a rate that you need it that benefits our municipalities. The PSATS person who talked about facetious requests on right to know law, we have a very facetious companies that operates in Perry County, I call them Brightspeed, the old CenturyLink company, it's probably the number one complaint I hear by constituents, so contact our office about a problem, such as a telephone pole laying on our tree or a telephone pole that snapped off for five years and laying on the ground; then the cable crew came out and patched the line together and the line is still laying on the ground. We've been pretty successful at getting Brightspeed to send out actual real line crew to repair the lines and get the lines up. So, if you have this issue in your township, please let my office know and we will work on it, we have been having pretty good success in getting them fixed when we know about them. Finally, if you have any issues or complaints, or ideas, suggestions, whatever, please contact our office, so please reach out to our staff. Thank you.

Perry County Commissioners Brian Allen and Larry Reisinger were present and addressed the Convention Body.

Commissioner Brian Allen - I am sure you are getting a lot of questions on the assessment. Larry will speak about that. We received a proposal which has taken a long time to move forward with an infrastructure grant. An infrastructure grant is really the best tool the township and boroughs will have to complete some long rather cost prohibitive projects you may have. It may be a road that has gotten bad, like Meadow Grove Road, or a culvert or a bridge, tiles under a certain road really any type of infrastructure. So, putting this grant together, we took 2 million dollars of the ARPA money and what it does is essentially turns 2 million dollars into 13, if you stretch it out. If the township doesn't have an engineer, many of you do, but if you don't, it's not going to be a problem to get these projects figured out, there will be a team that can come in and assist the township in any way you folks deem necessary. We just got the proposal, and we are forwarding to our solicitor and we expect to be voting on that here ins 2 to 3 weeks. Every township should be receiving a letter explaining it and the contact information, so you can take advantage of it or they can answer questions certainly better than me. Thank you.

Commissioner Larry Reisinger was next to speak. Good morning as Brian said, if you read the local newspaper for the last month, you are well aware that Perry County is going through a reassessment and there has been a lot of confusion that Perry County did not advertise that. So, we heard you say that, so on September 20th, Wednesday at the Family Life Center at 7 o'clock there is going to be an open meeting on the reassessment. Now the first part of that meeting is going to be an educational session presented by VISION, the name of the company we hired to do the reassessment. There has been a lot of miss information in the newspaper and passed around on social media, so we want them to do an education session on exactly what a reassessment is and does. Then it will be open to questions and answers, that for what we don't exactly have down yet. So, September 20th, 7 o'clock, Family Life

Center, my gut feeling is that when they are done with their educational part of their presentation that 50% of the questions, we, you, the populous of Perry County have, are going to be answered. If I can give you an example, I have been a commissioner now for 7 months, I took Gary Eby's place, who unfortunately had health issues. Prior to that, all my life I worked at auctions that sold real estate; let me give you an example, if you look out there, there is a farm, we have a sale there Saturday and that farm was assessed at \$400,000, we had the sale on Saturday and that farm raised a million dollars; all my life I naively assumed that it will now go on the tax roll at a million dollars. Not true, that's illegal, that's called selective reassessment. So even though assessment is supposed to reflect current market value, even though that brought a million dollars, it is staying on the tax roll at \$400,000. To me that is not fair. It is not the reassessment it is the millage rate that determines what our taxes are going to be. So, you're all invited September 20th and we will learn a lot and I will be around to answer what questions I can. Thank you, enjoy the rest of your day.

Marty Roberts of the Perry County Economic Development Authority, (PCEDA), addressed the Convention Body to explain what the PCEDA does. We have a volunteer board, and our job is to help grow the economy in Perry County. We currently have 120 thousand acres of farmland in the county and about a thousand acres of public land. And if you have a farm many of you have yours in a clean and green tax designation which is wonderful. But as townships and county mandates continue to rise and as millage grows, we have to find ways to strength the economy without changing Perry County, without doing harm and certainly we are not going to lose access to the Appalachian Trail, our rivers and our state park. So, our job is to work with existing businesses to help them strengthen their business and attract new businesses. Our primary project right now, if you haven't heard of it before, is that the 9 boroughs in the county have been designated as a Regional Named Street Program. We are helping businesses in the boroughs to reinvest dollars into their towns so that we can attract new visitors and keep those current customers that our businesses have. We also work closely with the four school districts. We lose too many of our great young people when they graduate from high school to move out of the county, so we have done a few things. We sponsored a career fair and had 40 local businesses attend and they had a very high rate of applications that were submitted to them from kids from 10th to 12th grade. We think of that as a victory. We also have a challenge with our high school age kids, to get them involved with Vo-Tech, it's just hard to get in because there are only so many slots and we are trying to make that better. One of our top priorities that we heard is from the nursing homes in our county that they really needed CNS-Certified Nursing Assistants to get jobs in our homes. We are working diligently with community college to try to get that certification done here in the county for our young people, so they don't have to worry about commuting to get them. We're very active in the state regional program called the Engaged Program where Michelle Jones is our Executive Director and Kylee Spidel is our Downtown Coordinator. We meet with local businesses to try and find out how they are doing; what they need; what could be better. The interview keeps us in touch with how our economy is growing, it is amazing. I'm sure you're all aware of this, people are very interested now in local products, local business and that is really helping some of our business in Perry County, which is a great thing and that you all for participating in that. We also have services for our businesses to help them with business plans and financial projections, all for free. You have to make an appointment, and we can help you. So, I just wanted you all to know that we are working diligently for you, and it is an honor to represent the county, and I appreciate the time. We are also sponsoring a Pickle Ball Tournament in Newport, there is men's, women's and mixed doubles, if successful we can continue this from year to year.

PERRY COUNTY ASSOCIATION OF TOWNSHIP OFFICIALS

CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS ARTICLE I PREAMBLE

The Perry County Association of Township Officials is organized under the authority of the Second-Class Township Code: and in any case of conflict between this Constitution and By-Laws and the pertinent sections in the Second-Class Code shall prevail.

ARTICLE II NAME

The Association shall be known as the Perry County Association of Township Officials and shall be the official organization of the Second-Class Township Code in Perry County, Pennsylvania.

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

This Association is formed for the purpose of considering and discussing questions and subjects pertaining to the best methods for the improvement of the Township governments, the assessment of property, the collection of taxes, the construction, improvement and maintenance of roads, and the promotion of mutual co-operation among the member townships.

ARTICLE IV MEMBERSHIP

Section 1. The membership shall consist of the Township Supervisors, the Township Secretaries, the Township Treasurers, The Township Auditors, The Township Tax Collectors of Perry County, Pennsylvania.

Section 2. By majority vote of any regular convention, full membership for life may be conferred upon any retired member who has rendered long and valuable service to Township government.

Section 3. Any member is entitled to vote on any question within the Association and any member can be elected to the office of President and Vice-President and can serve as delegate to the State Convention.

We want to make this easier and cheaper for you all, we want to include your thoughts and ideas as part of the roles and objectives in this process. The Tri-County Regional Planning Commission website you can access the PICTURE PERRY Comprehensive Plan, you can link it up to your own website if you have one, if it is a plan you participated in. There is a front end to this particular website that enables you to submit projects that can be worked into this comprehensive plan. Thank you.

With no further discussion, the Treasurer's Report was approved unanimously with a Terry Ulrich/Daisy Lightner motion.

By-Law Amendments Resolution was approved with revisions and corrections on a Jim Fuller/Art Lindsay motion.

Correction: Article IV, Section 2, word show, should read who.

Revision: Article VI, Section 1, Secretary/Treasurer – shall be one position.

Revision: Article VI, Section 3, the compensation shall be for Secretary/

Treasurer at \$500 per year.

Revision: Article VI, Section 4 there is no need for this section as it sets compensation for Treasurer.

There was a motion by Art Lindsay/Dale Beaver to accept the revisions to the resolution.

With no further discussion or business, the session broke for lunch.

After lunch, President Hess reconvened the General Session of the Convention Body. A round of applause was given to the Pamona Grange for a delicious ham luncheon.
