Commissioner Campbell said in keeping with the America250 celebrations, that the Pomona Grange was hosting a historical talk by Harriet Magee at the Shermanata Grange in Duncannon tomorrow. He also stated that the Perry County America250 Celebration would be held on April 19th at the Family Life Center in Newport.
