The Perry County LEPC is committed to supporting hazardous materials training for Perry County emergency service providers. The Perry County LEPC will pay for your HazMat class, provided that the following conditions are met:

1. The emergency service agency must notify the EMA Office at least 30 days prior to class start date. This will allow the EMA office to share the training opportunity with all County emergency service agencies and help track funding prior to expenditure.
2. The class must be open to all Perry County emergency service providers.
3. A roster of students must be submitted with the invoice.
4. The invoice must be issued by the educational institute and addressed directly to the Perry County LEPC. The invoice cannot be submitted by the agency to the LEPC as a reimbursement request.

These requirements are necessary to ensure equal access to training opportunities, proper funding oversight, and consistent processing of training expenses.

If you have any questions regarding eligibility of invoicing, please contact the Perry County EMA office.
