Commissioner Campbell opened the meeting at 10:00 a.m. on May 4, 2026 with the Pledge to the Flag and a moment of silence. The meeting was recorded by the County.

Updates/Announcements: Commissioner Lyons commented on his attendance at the Literacy Council – Race for Reading event on Saturday. He said it was well attended and a lot of money was raised.

Commissioner Campbell stated that he had attended the Newport FFA banquet on Friday. He commented that it is always a pleasure to see the students and the good they do.

Approval of Minutes: Commissioner Watson made a motion to approve the minutes of the April 27, 2026 meeting. Commissioner Lyons seconded the motion. All agreed. Motion carried unanimously.

Approval of the Warrant List(s): Commissioner Lyons made a motion to approve the warrant lists totaling 1,001,356.26. Commissioner Watson seconded the motion. All agreed

Meeting Business: Commissioner Lyons made a motion to approve the generator services proposal from Premium Power Services LLC for the Prison generator services at a semi-annual price of \$1,026. Commissioner Watson seconded the motion. All agreed. Motion carried unanimously.

Commissioner Watson made a motion to approve the agreement with Martson Law Offices for consulting counsel. Commissioner Lyons seconded the motion. All agreed. Motion carried unanimously.

Commissioner Watson made a motion to approve the service quotes from Spectrotel for backup internet at the Prison and Courthouse at a monthly cost of \$158 per location. Commissioner Lyons seconded the motion. All agreed. Motion carried unanimously.

Commissioner Lyons made a motion to approve the agreement with Messiah University for an internship affiliation program for Children & Youth Services. Commissioner Watson seconded the motion. Kristie Gantt, Children & Youth Director, stated that her department would be getting an intern from Messiah for the Child Welfare Education Program. She noted that there would be no cost to the County for the internship. All agreed. Motion carried unanimously.

Commissioner Lyons made a motion to approve the Cumberland-Perry Drug & Alcohol Commission contract (listed below). Commissioner Watson seconded the motion. All agreed. Motion carried unanimously.

Solicitor's Report: None

Post Comments: Tim Bassett, Deputy Warden, stated that the Perry County Prison has received a Proclamation from Governor Shapiro’s Office, designating May 3 – 9, 2026 as Corrections Employees Week in Pennsylvania. He said he wanted to make the public aware and thanked the Prison Board and Commissioners for their support.

Sarah Geesaman, Election Director, said that the last day to register to vote or make changes to your voter record was May 4. She noted that individuals are able to register and make changes online until 11:59 p.m. that day. She also stated that May 12 is the last day to apply for a mail in or absentee ballot.

Randy Waggoner, Chief Assessor commented that he, along with Darla McNaughton and Nicole Kelly, had been working with the business managers at the local school districts to assist them with their budgeting process. He said the assistance is needed as this would be the first year using the reassessment numbers and they must abide by the revenue neutral requirement.
